Guidelines for Audition/Final Performance:

1. Each student must complete **THIS ENTIRE PACKET** (with parent signature) and return them to Miss O'Halloran by March 5, 2018 in room 210 by 2:30 pm.
2. Please keep in mind that performance time is TBA due to the volume of permission slips handed in. **But as a guideline, performances may not exceed 3 minutes.**
3. Student must wear clothing appropriate to performance (keeping in mind that BMS dress code policy does apply).
4. If student chooses to perform with others, there should be no more than 6 students to a group. **All group performers must complete an individual permission slip**, but only one audition page per group.
5. Student must use appropriate language during performance (keeping in mind BMS discipline policy does apply).
6. Student routines should be practiced and organized with clear choreography. (Please keep in mind that this show is for all grades, so gestures, dance moves, etc. should be appropriate).
7. Student must bring his/her own music, props, costumes, instruments, other equipment, etc. to audition day and final performance. Music should have appropriate language. Please keep in mind that music should be formatted to play on CD.
8. Interested students will be provided at least one audition day and at least one rehearsal day prior to final performance. Final performance should mimic student audition with only minor adjustments.
9. The BMS Student Council Talent Show Committee will decide final order of performance. Students will be notified by Friday, March 9th of audition results. If your audition is accepted, it is expected that you will be able to attend the Rehearsal on Tuesday, March 13th and the Talent Show on Thursday, March 15th.
